Staying at Zilvermeer is always a blast! The natural setting and family atmosphere ensure an unforgettable vacation, at one of the most beautiful places in the Kempen region.

Zilvermeer is located in the 'Kempense Meren' tourist region, on the border of the provinces of Antwerp and Limburg and near the Dutch border.

For your stay, you can choose from:

- a pitch at our modern 4-star camping site
- 26 comfortable log cabins for 4 to 6 persons
- a lodge for groups of max. 50 persons
- 5 hiker's huts for 4 persons
- 2 holiday homes (100% accessible) for 6 persons (12 if combined)

Recreation for everyone

- Swimming pond with a guarded swimming area, spectacular water slides, water screens, whirlpools, ...
- Magnificent white sandy beach with a very gradual downward slope, also ideal for small children

Log Cabins

- For a comfortable stay, choose one of the 26 cosy log cabins, fully furnished for 4 to max. 6 persons.
- Ground floor: kitchen with cooking utensils, table and chairs, sitting area with sofa bed (can be converted into 2 single beds) and bathroom with shower, washbasin and toilet.
- First floor: 2 bedrooms, 4 single beds.
- There's nothing more fun than playing and eating outside, every log cabin has its own little garden!
- Cold outside? No problem, the log cabins have heating.
- Pets are not allowed for hygienic reasons.
- The log cabins also have a TV, microwave oven and coffee-maker.

Campsite

- Modern 4-star campsite
- 518 annual pitches
- 252 pitches for mobile homes
- 257 tourist and seasonal pitches
- 16 pitches at the camping lawn
- 8 group campsites (approx. 800 m² each)
- 20 camper pitches
- Our revamped campsite is known for its family and child-friendly atmosphere. For an annual pitch, you can either choose a well-shaded spot in the forest, or a sunny spot at the green camping site. As a tourist, you are welcome here with a tent, caravan or camper.
- All annual pitches have their own water point, electricity, sewer connection, radio and TV distribution.
- 🔅 Free internet
- Groups, clubs or families who want to stay close to each other, can opt for a large camping spot (approx. 8 ares).
- Especially for youngsters, the camping lawn has 16 pitches.
 - Mobile homes can park at the paved camper pitches.

Lodge

- Quietly located lodge for groups of max. 50 persons.
- Ground floor: fully equipped kitchen with cooking utensils, freezer, steamer and cutlery; central area, with moveable furniture; sanitary facilities: showers, washbasins and toilets.
- First floor: dormitory with 16 bunk beds and 4 separate rooms with a bunk bed for accompanying persons.
- Second floor: 10 single beds.
- Sports facilities and playground in the vicinity.
- A campfire is possible upon request.
- Pets are not allowed in the accommodations for hygienic reasons.
- The lodge is ideal for forest classes ('Zilverklassen'), with schools working on topics such as forests, water and sand. Students will not only learn about nature, they will 'experience' nature. In addition, we combine our nature education vision with a well-considered and pedagogically justified sports and play programme.

Hiker's hut

- The hiker's huts are a functional and inexpensive form of accommodation. Every hut comes with a table, 4 chairs, 4 beds, a simple cooking area and heating. The advantage is that you don't need to drag along a tent, sleeping mats or cooker; a sleeping bag and pillowcase will suffice.
- Zilvermeer has five hiker's huts (15m²); you can cook yourself or eat out in one of our restaurants. There is no room to do any washing in the hut itself, but the recreation centre has excellent sanitary facilities.
- Pets are not allowed in the accommodations for hygienic reasons.
- A hiker's hut is the ideal place in combination with a cycling or hiking vacation. If you don't bring your own bike, you can rent one at the park (children's bicycles and seats as well). Even electric bicycles are available (please book in advance)
- Zilvermeer has been awarded the 'bicycle-friendly campsite' quality label. This label guarantees high-quality overnight stays, specifically focusing on bicycle tourists.

100% Accessible homes



The park has two 100% accessible holiday homes, which are extremely suited for groups or families with disabled persons or persons with reduced mobility.

Each home can accommodate 6 persons. The homes can also be combined, for a total of 12 persons. In addition to specific facilities for wheelchair users, they are also equipped with facilities for the visually impaired, such as colour contrasts.



For groups, schools and companies

- Hiking, cycling, touring with a passenger boat... Zilvermeer is the ideal location for all these activities. In addition, the Ecocentre always has tourist information at your disposal and groups can participate in nature education activities.

- Zilvermeer is also a patch of pristine nature. Boasting a wide variety of fauna and flora, the 'Meer- en Buitengoor' protected swampland is unique in Flanders. Visit the nature education trail, or go on a guided walk (only for groups).

Water sports

- Sailing, surfing, kayaking (for groups and by reservation), diving: anything goes at our water sports pond! Upon request, expert monitors of the water sports school can teach you the ins and outs of water sports.
- The best diving spot in the Benelux; even in the summer, visibility is up to 10 metres (no blue algae)! Hot showers, changing cubicles, a filling station, a cool underwater course and a cafeteria with a terrace jutting out across the water. Facilities for disabled persons.
- The 'Underwater Park for Fine Arts' features 55 objects you can view via different compass courses. Also visit the sunken (and lit) city!
- Deep-sea diving (25-30 metres) or fish spotting are possible in the adjacent canal lake, with a boat dive.
- 'Port Aventura', the magnificent Zilvermeer marina. Unique location on a 85-hectare canal lake, completely surrounded by nature. Ideal for a boat trip on the lake, or use the extensive cycling and hiking route network. Permanent berths for pleasure yachters, but there are berths for transients as well.
